

TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE FOR COSMETIC SECTOR IN 2006

1. Assistance by Germany

1.1 Activities

1.2 Funding arrangements by Germany

Funding for participants:

Funding support under the PBT will follow the Guidelines of the German Development Cooperation for any aids in which LDCs, developing countries and non-developing countries will be given a different financial supports as follows:

- Cambodia, Lao PDR and Myanmar: travel costs, accommodation and daily allowance.
- Indonesia, Malaysia, Philippines, Thailand and Viet Nam: only accommodation and daily allowance.
- Singapore and Brunei Darussalam are not eligible for funding support.

Contribution from ASEAN Member Countries:

The host country will cover all logistic arrangements such as meeting room, tea/ coffee break, lunch for speakers and participants.

2. Assistance by Australia

2nd Regional Workshop on Good Regulatory Practice (GRP) for ASEAN Regulatory Authorities will be conducted tentatively in 2006 in Singapore, subject to confirmation by Singapore. Funding support will be provided for participants and the host country.

3. Assistance by the International Trade Centre (ITC)**3.1 Activities**

The ITC has agreed in principle to provide funding for ASEAN to conduct the following activities in 2006:

- a. In-depth Regional Training of Trainers on PMS for regulators from Cambodia, Lao PDR and Viet Nam.
- b. Advanced Regional Training of Trainers on PMS for regulators and industry (SMEs, importer and distributors) from Cambodia, Indonesia, Lao PDR, Malaysia, Philippines, Thailand and Viet Nam.
- c. National Follow-Up Training on PMS for Indonesia, Malaysia, Philippines, Thailand and Viet Nam.
- d. Regional Follow-Up from the Advanced Regional Training and National Trainings on PMS to evaluate the performance of trainees who have participated in the advanced regional training.
- e. In-Depth Regional Training of Trainers on GMP for 30 regulators and industry.
- f. National Follow-up Training on GMP for regulators and industry in 5 countries, which have a number of cosmetic industry (Indonesia, Malaysia, Philippines, Thailand and Viet Nam).
- g. Technical support for Lao PDR, Cambodia and Viet Nam in setting up notification system for cosmetic products.

3.2 Funding arrangement

The ITC and the ASEAN Secretariat are now working on funding arrangements and it is expected that announcement can be made to Member Countries by January 2006.
