

1. That tooth bleaching/whitening products (except toothpastes) containing between >0.1 and 6% of H₂O₂ present or released should be classified as cosmetic products and regulated under the ASEAN Cosmetic Directive.
2. That the ACD Annexe III Part 2 is amended to reflect the changes made in the EU Cosmetic Directive Annexe III Part 2, allowing provisional use of hydrogen peroxide subject to the restrictions laid down as listed below.
3. That the ACSB continues formal contact with COLIPA and other appropriate European organisations to monitor progress of implementation of the the supporting measures for this change and assess any implications for ASEAN as a permanent agenda item for the next 12 months.
