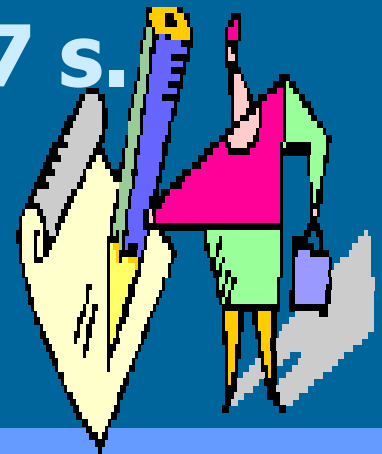
First GMP guide for **cosmetic** manufacturers.



1998

The Joint BFAD-Cosmetic Industry Study Group has adopted the guiding principles for Good Manufacturing Practice guidelines in the manufacture of cosmetic products.

OBJECTIVES

- **To assist the cosmetic industry in compliance with the harmonized ASEAN Cosmetic Regulatory Scheme.**
- **To issue license to manufacture cosmetic products only upon compliance with Cosmetic Current Good Manufacturing Practice.**

POLICIES

- **The Department of Health adopts the current ASEAN Cosmetic GMP guidelines.**
- **Cosmetic products shall be manufactured using methods, facilities, and control procedures adequate to preserve their quality and safety.**
- **The quality of cosmetic products depend on the starting materials, production, quality control processes, building/facility, equipment, personnel involved and testing protocols.**

GMP Issues

- Supplier control
- QA system
- Production and packaging specifications
- Preventive maintenance and calibration
- Prevention of cross contamination
- Receipt storage and shipping
- Traceability and recall

Plan of Action

- Series of Seminars to be conducted for the In-depth training workshop on ASEAN GMP Guide for cosmetics
- Complete GMP training from January-December 2006.
- cGMP audit to be conducted to all cosmetic manufacturers to assess the level of compliance with cGMP.
- Target all companies to be GMP compliant by end of 2007.

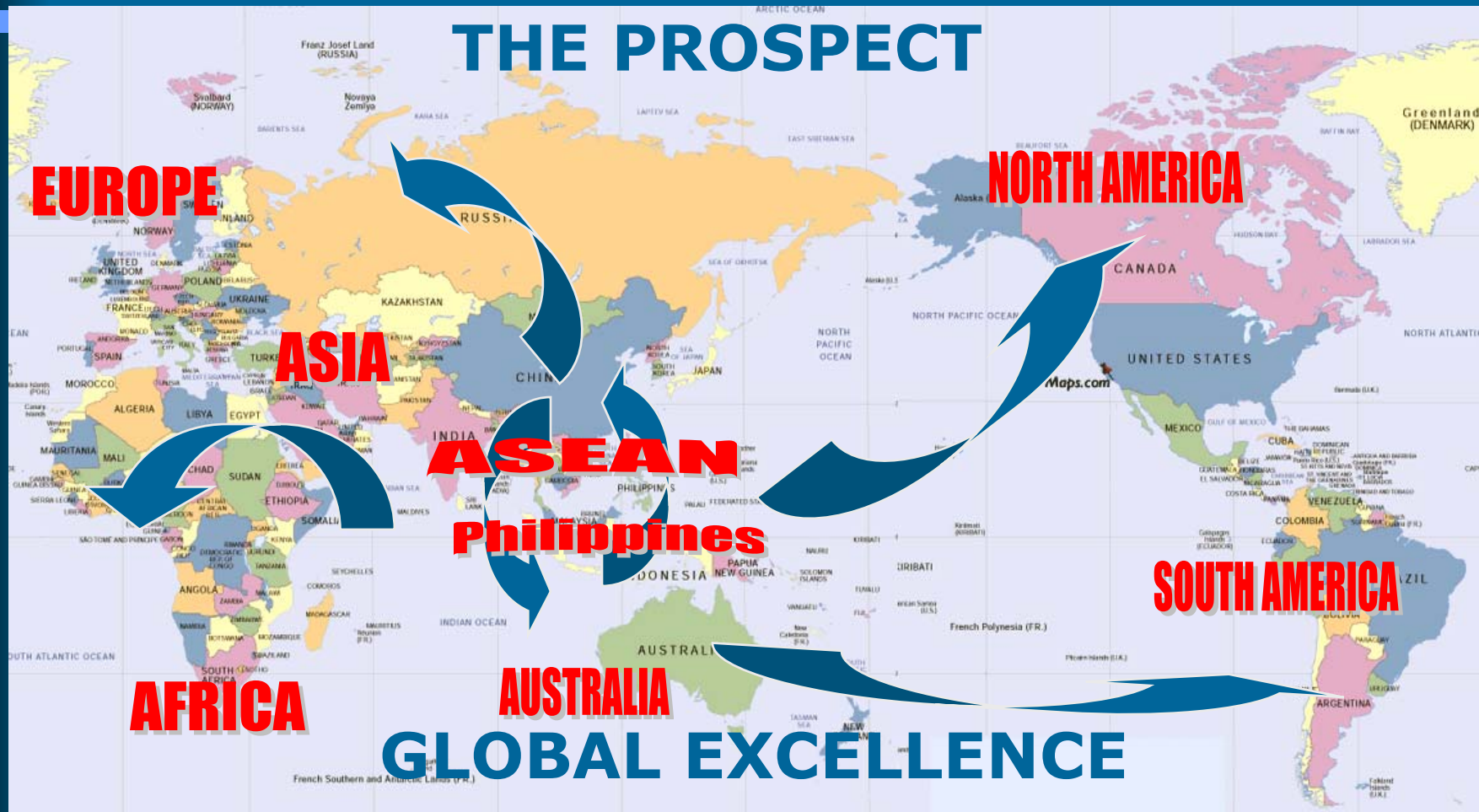
